

RCPCH-NIHR PIER Prize 2021

The PIER (Paediatric Involvement and Engagement in Research) Prize recognises excellent patient engagement and significant contributions to the NIHR Clinical Research Network. This Prize is open to research active paediatricians and multidisciplinary research teams who make outstanding contributions to involve paediatric patients and families in the development and delivery of research.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for this award you must deliver a research study on the NIHR Clinical Research Network Portfolio. Any research active paediatrician or paediatric focused research team is eligible to apply. The individual or team should highlight their contribution to excellent paediatric patient/family engagement in the design and delivery of NIHR Clinical Research Network Portfolio studies.

Submission Criteria

Applicants are required to outline their contribution to NIHR Clinical Research Children's Portfolio studies with weight being attached to:

- how patients and families have been engaged and informed of new opportunities to participate in clinical research.
- co-production in the development and delivery of studies.
- innovative methods of study delivery.

Prize

The winner(s) will receive a trophy and day entry pass for up to four members of the research team to RCPCH Conference and Exhibition 2021 (including reasonable expenses) where they will be presented with the Prize by the RCPCH President.

How to submit your application

Those eligible for and wishing to be considered for 2021 RCPCH-NIHR Prize should complete the following form no later than midnight on **30 November 2020**. All forms are to be returned to the RCPCH research team via email. Once we have received your application you will receive a receipt of application within two working-days. If you have not received a receipt of application, please contact us. The results of the competition will be announced in February 2021.



What information do we collect from you?

This privacy notice relates to the information we collect for the RCPCH-NIHR PIER Prize. To enable us to consider the submission, we require the following information as part of the submission form:

Submissions for the prize are voluntary and we will only use the personal data you have provided on this form for the application process. Please ensure you have consent of all applicants before submitting their personal data.

Who do we share your information with?

Your personal data will be held within the RCPCH Research & Evidence team. The judging committee will also view the applications.

We will never transfer your information outside of the EEA.

How long do we keep your information?

We will retain applications for five years from the year of submission in line with the College Retention Policy. We will then destroy unsuccessful applications and transfer successful nominations to the College's historical archive for long term preservation.

Your rights

Under GDPR you have certain rights in regard to the data we hold about you. You can ask us to delete your personal data (called a right to be forgotten), change any inaccuracies, restrict what we use your personal data for or ask us to stop processing your personal data.
