This call for research proposals was a key component of the NIHR's response to recognition of the need for further research-based evidence related to the provision of primary care services in the NHS:

- through supporting capacity building across a wide range primary care disciplines
- increasing the volume of high-quality research on the effectiveness, delivery and organisation of primary care interventions and services
